**A RESOLUTION OF THE NEWTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO  
APPOINT COMMISSIONER STANLEY EDWARDS TO THE NEWTON COUNTY  
SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 2020**

**WHEREAS**, the Constitution of the State of Georgia, approved by the voters of the State in November of 1982, and effective July 1, 1983, provides in Article IX, Section II, Paragraph I thereof, that the governing authority of each county may adopt clearly reasonable ordinances, resolutions and regulations relating to its property, affairs and local government for which no provision has been made by general law and which is not inconsistent with the Constitution or any local law; and

**WHEREAS**, Commissioner Nancy Schulz will step down from the Newton County Solid Waste Management Authority effective September 30, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, at least three Directors of the Newton County Solid Waste Management Authority shall be elected officials of Newton County; and

**WHEREAS**, upon Commissioner Schulz' departure from the Newton County Solid Waste Management Authority, the Board of Commissioners must appoint an elected official to serve as a Director for the Newton County Solid Waste Management Authority; and

**WHEREAS**, the Newton County Board of Commissioners wishes to appoint Commissioner Stanley Edwards to serve as a Director for the Newton County Solid Waste Management Authority effective October 1, 2020.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF NEWTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Commissioner Stanley Edwards is hereby appointed to serve as a Director for the Newton County Solid Waste Management Authority for a four-year term; and
2. The appointment of Commissioner Stanley Edwards is effective as of October 1, 2020.
