

**A RESOLUTION OF THE NEWTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
APPROVING THE ANNUAL SALARY FOR THE NEWTON COUNTY JUVENILE
COURT CHIEF JUDGE AS SET BY THE SUPERIOR COURT FOR THE ALCOVY
JUDICIAL CIRCUIT**

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the State of Georgia, approved by the voters of the State in November of 1982, and effective July 1, 1983, provides in Article IX, Section II, Paragraph I thereof, that the governing authority of each county may adopt clearly reasonable ordinances, resolutions, and regulations; and

WHEREAS, O.C.G.A. § 15-11-52(b) provides, "The compensation of the full-time or part-time juvenile court judges shall be set by the superior court with the approval of the governing authority or governing authorities of the county or counties for which the juvenile court judge is appointed;" and


WHEREAS, the Superior Court for the Alcovy Judicial Circuit desires to set the salary of the Newton County Juvenile Court Chief Judge at \$120,116.57 annually; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desires to approve the annual salary for the Newton County Juvenile Court Chief Judge as set by the Superior Court bench in accordance with O.C.G.A. § 15-11-52(b).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Newton County, Georgia that the \$120,116.57 annual salary for the Newton County Juvenile Court Chief Judge is hereby approved.
